On a rotating basis, the incumbent will serve as Senior in Charge of the building in the absence of a manager.

Qualifications: MLS/MLIS from an ALA accredited program required; students within 6 credits of graduation are encouraged to apply. Knowledge of youth literature and popular culture is essential; valid Ohio driver's license required.
